What do I already know?

Talk about what they see, using a wide vocabulary. Begin to make sense of their own life-story and family's history.
Continue to develop positive attitudes about the differences between people.

What will I know by the end of the unit?

Explain why Christians say Jesus is special.

Develop curiosity as to why Christians do nativity plays at Christmas

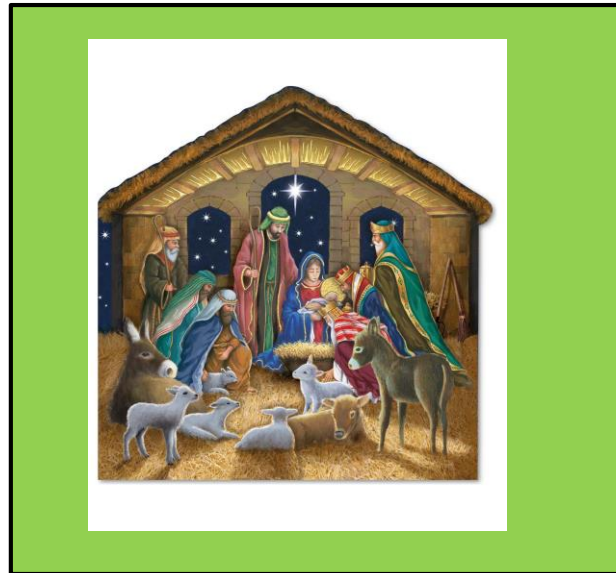
Explain why Christians give and receive presents at Christmas.

Talk about some things Christians might do in church and that the church is a special place for Christian

That Jesus is a special person for Christians and can tell you about his birth .

Take part in a nativity to retell the Christmas Story

Discuss what Christmas means to us and how we celebrate.



Key Vocabulary	Definition
Christmas	It is a holiday to celebrate the birth of Jesus Christ, who, according to the Christian religion, is the son of God
God	Some Christians believe that God created our world
Church	The place where some Christians go to worship
Nativity	The story of how Jesus was born
Christians	Christians are people who believe that Jesus Christ is the Son of God
