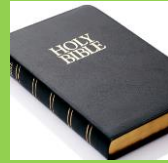
What do I already know?

Why was Jesus a teacher and leader? What happened at the feeding of 5000	<input type="checkbox"/> <i>The story of The Feeding of the 5000</i> <input type="checkbox"/> Christians believe that God can do things which we can't. <input type="checkbox"/> The Miracles which Jesus did showed that he was special and had a relationship with God that everyone else didn't have.
Why do Christians believe that Jesus was a healer?	<input type="checkbox"/> People were often brought to Jesus to see if he would make them feel better <input type="checkbox"/> <i>The story of Jairus' Daughter</i> <input type="checkbox"/> Christians talk to Jesus, through prayer, about the things that are worrying them. They ask for his help.
Why was Jesus' death part of a bigger plan for Christians?	
What is the resurrection?	<input type="checkbox"/> Resurrection is the Christian belief that he returned to life by a miracle. <input type="checkbox"/> He died by crucifixion on Friday and rose from his tomb to new life on Sunday morning. <input type="checkbox"/> This gives Christians the hope of a new life after death.
Why do Christians follow Jesus?	<input type="checkbox"/> Christians believe that the Bible can show them the right sort of people to follow / learn from to become better people <input type="checkbox"/> Sometimes when Christians are faced with problems they ask themselves 'What would Jesus Do?' <input type="checkbox"/> Some Christians go on a special journey to visit the places where Jesus went, this is called a pilgrimage.

Key Vocabulary	Definition
Disciples	Followers of Jesus
Miracle Maker	Jesus performed extraordinary events of good which were taken as a sign of the power of God.
Healer	Make someone better
Parable	A short story that teaches a moral or spiritual lesson especially : one of the stories told by Jesus Christ and recorded in the Bible.
Jesus the Teacher	Of the 90 times Jesus was addressed directly in the gospels, 60 times he was called Teacher. Jesus teaches us through the parables.
Resurrection	The Christian belief that he returned to life by a miracle. He died by crucifixion on Friday and rose from his tomb to new life on Sunday morning. This belief is celebrated at Easter. This gives Christians the hope of a new life after death.
New Testament	The Old Testament is the first part of the Bible and it's made up of 39 books. Before Jesus, the story of the Jews.
Pilgrimage	A journey to a holy place
