How can I present a story in 3 ways?

- You will look at a traditional tale presented as a mind map, as a quiz, as an e-book and as a fact file.

How can I make a quiz about a story or class topic.

- You will make a quiz about a story using 2Quiz.
- You will be able to talk about your work and make improvements to solutions based on feedback received.

How can I make a fact file on a non-fiction topic?

- You will use information from a 2Connect file to make a publisher fact file on a non-fiction topic.
- You will add appropriate clipart.
- You will add an appropriate photo.

How can I make a presentation to the class?

- You can use a variety of software to manipulate and present digital content and information.
- You can collect, organise and present data and information in digital content.
- You can create digital content to achieve a given goal by combining software packages.

Key Vocabulary

- **E-book** An electronic version of a printed book that can be read on a computer or a specifically designed handheld device.
- **Fact file** A document containing all the important information about one subject.
- **Fiction** A book or story that is written about imaginary characters and events and not based on real people or places.
- **Mind map** A tool for organising and representing knowledge. They form a web of ideas which are all interconnected.
- **Node** A way to represent a concept or idea using text and/or images.
- **Non-fiction** Writing that is about real people or events rather than stories that have been made up.
- **Presentation** A way of displaying information about a subject to an audience.
- **Quiz** A test of knowledge, especially as a competition between individuals or teams as a form of entertainment.

You know that data can be structured in tables to make it useful to present
